

## Guidelines for Scholarship Rocky Mountain Friends Women

1. This scholarship is to be for college preparation of ministry/missionary students.
2. The student applying for a scholarship must give a clear and up-to-date testimony of a born-again experience.
3. He/she must give a definite witness as to God's calling into ministry/missionary work, which would include ministerial training, nursing, teaching linguistics, Christian Education, etc.
4. The student preferably should be a member of Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting.
5. The student shall send an application to the Scholarship Committee chairperson.
6. It is preferred that the Scholarship be given to a student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting attending a Friends college or a student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting attending seminary. The Scholarship Committee has the liberty to consider a deserving student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting preparing for full-time Christian service that may be attending a Christian college other than a Friends college, in years that a student from a Friends school does not apply.
7. The student should be willing, if possible, to do on-the-job training at Rough Rock, EFI-NA Youth Ambassador programs, etc., for a period of time.
8. The Scholarship Committee must receive letters of reference from a pastor, a teacher, a business person, and a friend.
9. This scholarship is for one student, \$250 per semester, or \$500 a year, depending upon the setup of the school he/she attends.
10. The final awarding of the scholarship would be subject to discussion and approval of the Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Friends Women Board.
11. If several students are applying for the scholarship, it is preferable to give the scholarship to one qualified student.
