

# Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Scholarship

## Friends Women Guidelines

1. This scholarship is to be for college preparation of ministry/missionary students. This scholarship is for one student, \$250 per semester, or \$500 a year, depending upon the setup of the school he/she attends.
2. It is preferred that the Scholarship be given to a student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting attending a Friends college or a student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting attending seminary.
  - The Scholarship Committee has the liberty to consider a deserving student from Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting preparing for full-time Christian service that may be attending a Christian college other than a Friends college, in years that a student from a Friends school does not apply.
  - If several students are applying for the scholarship, it is preferable to give the scholarship to one qualified student.
3. Scholarship Requirements:
  - The student applying for a scholarship must give a clear and up-to-date testimony of a born-again experience.
  - He/she must give a definite witness as to God's calling in ministry/missionary work, which would include ministerial training, nursing, teaching linguistics, Christian Education, etc.
  - The student preferably should be a member of a Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting church.
  - The student should be willing, if possible, to do on-the-job training at an Evangelical Friends Mission (EFM) location for a period.
4. Applications can be downloaded from [www.rmym.org](http://www.rmym.org). The student should send the application to the Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Office, 2748 E. Pikes Peak Ave. Colorado Springs, CO 80909. It will be forwarded to the Friends Women Scholarship Committee.
5. The Scholarship Committee must receive letters of reference from a pastor, a teacher, a business person, and a friend.
6. The final awarding of the scholarship will be subject to discussion and approval of the Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Friends Women Executive Board.
7. Deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup> each year.
