

Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting Scholarship Program Through Barclay College

The Rocky Mountain Yearly Meeting (RMYM) Scholarship Program has been established at Barclay College by RMYM to assist in the training of RMYM students for ministry endeavors. Although the Yearly Meeting's primary concern is for the preparation of pastoral ministry students, other RMYM students may be considered for scholarship funds upon recommendation by the RMYM Superintendent /Leadership Facilitator or a designated person provided by the RMYM Elder Board.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. The applicant must be a regular participant in good standing in a RMYM Friends Church.
2. The applicant must initially complete an application form from the Financial Aid Office at Barclay College, 607 N. Kingman, Haviland, KS 67059. Upon receipt of the application, a formal request for recommendation from RMYM will be made by the Director of Financial Aid.
3. The applicant must meet Barclay College's Institutional Scholarship Policy requirements as follows:
 - a. The student must complete the required government financial aid forms.
 - b. The student must carry a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.
 - c. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA. A first-year student will not be eligible unless his or her high school transcript reflects a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
 - d. The student must maintain a Christian example and attitude on campus and in the community.
 - e. The student must complete Christian Service as assigned.
 - f. The student must be in good standing with all policies and regulations listed in the College's Student Handbook.
4. The applicant must be ministry-minded in character and direction.
5. This award will not exceed \$4,000 per year for a maximum of four years. The applicant must reapply each year and must demonstrate significant financial need. The amount of the award will not be guaranteed from one year to the next.
6. This award will be presented only after all other forms of scholarships and grants are credited to the student's account.
7. The student's acceptance of this scholarship indicated his or her intention to pursue a program of study at Barclay College and further indicates that the student is in sympathy with the aims and purposes of the College.
8. Failure to maintain scholarship requirements will result in withdrawal of the scholarship.
