Friends Women continues to grow spiritually and physically in memberships as we support missionaries and mission fields with our project funds. We also support RMYM women and their friends through our women's retreats. We presently have five active Friends Women's groups. Our mission as Friends Women is: **uniting women in Jesus Christ, while raising money and awareness for our EFM and other mission fields.**

Our project funds for 2019 provided \$1000 to Quaker Ridge to help with their water project and \$648 for Bhutan to purchase water filters. The funding for our yearly projects comes from the \$20.00 we ask each member of a Friends Women's group to pay as dues each year. Our Project for 2020 is going to Bangladesh to fund their Widow and Orphan Support.

The 2019-2020 school year Friends Women Scholarship was given to Isaac Wright, from Colorado Spring Friends Church. He is a member of First Friends Church of Colorado Springs and a freshman at Barclay College. We encourage you to inform your High School Seniors and graduates to submit an application for the Scholarship if they are seeking to serve others through missions.
